In the name of Allah, the *Rahmān* (Most Beneficent), the *Raheem* (Most Merciful)

رَبَّنَا اغْفِرْ لَنَا ذُنُوبَنَا وَإِسْرَافَنَا فِي أَمْرِنَا وَثَبِّتْ أَقْدَامَنَا وَانصُرْنَا عَلَى الْقَوْمِ الْكَافِرِينَ

**Rabbana-Ghfir Lanā Dhunoobanā Wa Isrāfanā Fī Amrinā

“Our Lord! Forgive us our sins and anything we may have done that transgressed our duty; Establish our feet firmly, and help us against those that resist Faith.” (3:147)

رَبَّنَا أَفْرِغْ عَلَيْنَا صَبْرًا وَ تَوْفَنَّا مُسْلِمِينَ

Rabbanā Afrigh 'Alainā Ṣabran Wa Tawaffanā Muslimeen (7:126)

“Our Lord! Pour out on us patience and constancy, and take our souls unto thee as Muslims.” (7:126)

رَبَّنَا تَقَبَّلْ مِنَّا إِنَّكَ أَنْتَ السَّمِيعُ الْعَلِيمُ

Rabbanā Taqabbal Minnā Innaka Anta-s-Samee'-ul-Aleem (2:127)

“Our Lord! Accept from us; For Thou art the All-Hearing, the All-knowing.” (2:127)

رَبِّ لَا تَذَرْنِي فَرْدًا وَأَنْتَ خَيْرُ الْوَارِثِينَ

Rabbi Lā Tadharnī Fardan Wa Anta Khair-ul-Wāritheen (21:89)

“O my Lord! Leave me not without offspring, though thou art the best of inheritors.” (21:89)

Recite each of the above verses 11 times

Iftar (Opening of the Fast): Before the opening, recite the Fatiha Niyāz, followed by the verse in the above order (each verse 11 times) with complete attention and concentration.

Sahar (Dawn): Before the Morning Prayer, recite the Fatiha Niyāz, followed by the verses in the same manner (each verse 11 times) with inner beseech.
