بِسْمِ اللَّهِ الرَّحْمَنِ الرَّحِيمِ

Bismi-l-Lāhi-r-Rahmāni-r-Raheem

In the name of Allah, the *Rahmān* (Most Beneficent), the *Raheem* (Most Merciful)

اللَّهُ لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا هُوَ الْحَيُّ الْقَيُّوْمُ

***Allāhu lā ilāha illā hu al-ḥayy al-qayyūm* (3:2)**

Allah! There is no god but He, the Alive, the Eternal. (3: 2)

وَاللَّهُ أَعْلَمُ بِأَعْدَائِكُمْ وَكَفَى بِاللَّهِ نَصِيرًا

***wa-llāhu a'lamu bi-a'dā'ikum wa-kafā bi-llāhi waliyyan wa-kafā bi-llāhi naṣīra* (4:45)**

But Allah best knows your enemies. Allah is enough for a protector, and Allah is enough for a Helper. (4:45)

يَا أَيُّهَا الَّذِينَ آمَنُوا أَوْفُوا بِالْعُهُودِ

***yā ayyuhā alladhi nā āmanū awfū bi-l-'uqūd* (5:1)**

O ye who believe! fulfil obligations. (5:1)

فَإِذَا مَسَّ الْإِنْسَانَ ضُرٌّ دَعَانَا ثُمَّ إِذَا حَوَّلْنَاهُ نِعْمَةً مِنَّا قَالَ إِنَّمَا أُوتِيتُهُ عَلَى عِلْمٍ بَلْ هِيَ فِتْنَةٌ وَلَكِنَّ أَكْثَرَهُمْ لَا يَعْلَمُونَ
fa-idhā massa al-insāna ḥurrūn da'ānā thumma idhā khawwalnāhu nī'matan minnā qāla innamā ūtītuhu 'alā 'ilmin bal hiya fitnatun wa-lākinna aktharahum lā ya'lamūna (39:49)

Now, when trouble touches man, he cries to Us. But when We bestow a favour upon him as from Ourselves, he says, "This has been given to me because of a certain knowledge!" Nay, but this is but a trial, but most of them understand not! (39:49)

هُوَ الَّذِي أَنْزَلَ السَّكِينَةَ فِي قُلُوبِ الْمُؤْمِنِينَ لِيُرْزَأُوا إِيمَانًا مَعَ إِيمَانِهِمْ وَلَهُ جُنُودُ السَّمَاوَاتِ وَالْأَرْضِ وَكَانَ اللَّهُ عَلَيْمًا حَكِيمًا
huwa alladhi anzala as-sakīnata fī qulūbi al-mu'minīna li-yazdādū īmānan ma'a īmānihim wa-li-llāhi junūdu as-samāwāti wa-al-ardi wa-kāna Allāhu 'alīman ḥakīma (48:4)

It is He Who sent down tranquillity into the hearts of the Believers, that they may add faith to their faith;- for to Allah belong the Forces of the heavens and the earth; and Allah is the Knower, the Wise (48:4)

هُوَ الْأَوَّلُ وَالْآخِرُ وَالظَّاهِرُ وَالبَاطِنُ وَهُوَ بِكُلِّ شَيْءٍ عَلِيمٌ

***huwa al-awwalu wa-al-ākhīru wa-z-zāhīru wa-al-bāṭīnu wa-huwa bi-kulli shay'in 'alīm* (57:3)**

He is the First and the Last, and the Outward and the Inward; and He is Knower of all things. (57:3)

وَمَا يَدْكُونَ إِلَّا أَنْ يَشَاءَ اللَّهُ هُوَ أَهْلُ التَّقْوَىٰ وَأَهْلُ الْمَغْفِرَةِ

***wa-mā yadhkūrūna illā an yashā'a Allāh, huwa ahlu t-taqwā wa-ahlu l-maghfirah* (74:56)**

But none will keep it in remembrance except as Allah wills. He is the Lord of Righteousness, and the Lord of Forgiveness. (74:56)

Recite each of the above verses 11 times

Iftar (Opening of the Fast): Before the opening, recite the Fatiha Niyāz, followed by the verses in the above order (each verse 11 times) with complete attention and concentration.

Sahar (Dawn): Before the Morning Prayer, recite the Fatiha Niyāz, followed by the verses in the same manner (each verse 11 times) with inner beseech.
